The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 20.12.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 37646 of 2018. The operative part of the said order is reproduced below:

“Without going into the merits of the case or expressing any opinion to the entitlement of the petitioner in respect of the claim prayed in the present writ petition or in the representation, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate speaking order on the claim raised by the petitioner in the representation dated 18.12.2017 (Annexure P-30) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

In case after the order, it is found by the respondents that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits, the

same should also be released to him within a period of next three months.

The writ petition stands disposed of.”

Reply dated 27.9.2019 by way of affidavit of Ms. Indu Malhotra, Director Public Instructions (Colleges), Punjab annexing order dated 17.9.2019 filed in court is taken on record, copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the claim of the petitioner has been partly accepted. He seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for surviving grievance.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.
