The present application has been filed to implead the LRs of respondent No.1-Raja Ram, who has died on 27.12.2005. Copy of death certificate of deceased respondent No.1-Raja Ram is annexed as Annexure A-2. The proposed LRs are sons of the deceased. Application is duly supported by an affidavit. Main case (O&M)
