SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. Instant writ petition has been filed seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondents no. 1 to 6, to provide security to the petitioners as well as to his family from the hands of the private respondents as also for directing the official respondents to maintain law and order situation in village Charkhi, District Charkhi Dadri. Yet another prayer has been made for directing official respondents to constitute a Special Investigation Team as the local police, who is alleged to be working under the influence of respondent No.11, who is MLA of the ruling party.

2. Pursuant to notice issued by this Court, written statement has been filed on behalf of official respondents No. 1 to 3, 5 to 6, wherein it

has been stated that a complaint received from the petitioner has been investigated and it has been found that there is no threat to the petitioner. The allegation levelled by the petitioner that his son Vikram @ Deepak was socially boycotted and he attempted to commit suicide, has also not been found to have been substantiated. In particular, reference deserves to be made to para 5 and 6 of the response, which are reproduced hereunder:-

“5. That during enquiry, petitioner and named respondents were joined in enquiry and their statements were recorded. During enquiry it has been found that village Charkhi district Charkhi Dadri is situated between two canals, due to which further cultivation of paddy crop has raised the underground water level of the village, which is presently about 2/3 feet's from ground. In order to redress the problem, the villagers had unanimously decided about 12/13 year before not to sow paddy crop in the village. However, petitioner Kuldeep and his family members have sown paddy crop. Despite that none of the villager has raised any objection nor has anyone issued any threat to the petitioner, his family or others. The decision to ban sowing of paddy crop is a common decision of the villagers. However, if anyone wants to sow paddy crop, none of the villager have any objection.

6. That with regard to complaint regarding attempt to commit suicide by Vikram @ Deepak due to social boycott, during enquiry no evidence has come on file to indicate that Vikram has in fact attempted to commit suicide or the same was abetted by the panchayat decision. Expert

opinion from Medical Board of PGIMS, Rohtak has been obtained regarding nature of injuries suffered by Vikram as to whether the same can be result of falling or otherwise and the medical board vide report dated 17.10.2023 has opined that 'after examination of Vikram, who refused to undergo CECT and MRI of neck region as advised by the board, the board is of the opinion that sustaining of possibility of injury mentioned in MLR due to allege manner asked by police could not be ruled out, there is no clinical feature suggestive of fracture of hyoid bone and nature of injury could not be given at this stage due to lack of radiological investigation.' True copy of the opinion of medical board is annexed herewith as Annexure R-1."

3. In view of the above, there is no merit in the writ petition, which is dismissed.
