1. Present petition is filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of FIR No. 7 dated 27.08.2022 registered under Sections 406, 419 and 420 of Indian Penal Code at Cyber Crime Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar (Annexure P-1) along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 12.04.2023 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.

2. Learned State counsel at the very outset submits that in the FIR(supra), petitioner along with one Rama Shankar has been nominated as accused, whereas the perusal of compromise clearly indicates that this is a partial compromise only with one of the accused, which is not permissible in terms of the reference answered by the Division Bench of this Court in CRM-M-48043-2023 decided on 12.11.2024 titled as '*Rakesh Das Vs. State of Haryana and Another*'.

3. In view of the above, present petition is disposed of as such.
