VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J. (ORAL)

By way of the instant petition, preferred under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, the petitioners allege willful disobedience of order dated 15.01.2024 (Annexure P-4), passed by a Division Bench of this Court in CWP-773-2024, titled "**Asa Ram and another v. State of Punjab and others.**"

2. Vide order (Annexure P-4), respondent No.2-Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, SAS Nagar (Mohali) was directed to take a decision on the representation dated 26.12.2023, submitted by the petitioners, by passing a speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing, preferably within one month from the date of receipt of a copy of the said order.

3. Mr. Rohit Gupta, Advocate, has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents and has furnished a copy of order dated 29.04.2024, which is a speaking order passed in compliance of the directions issued by the



Division Bench, as referred to above. Learned counsel submits that the said order was passed after having granted due opportunity of hearing to petitioner No.1-Asa Ram and Smt. Usha Devi, daughter of petitioner No.2-Mewa Ram, who appeared on his behalf.

4. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. Accordingly, the contempt petition is disposed of in terms of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents.

5. Rule is discharged.

6. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
