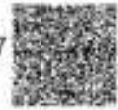

SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral):

1. The petitioner is facing prosecution for the commission of offence punishable under Sections 115(2), 117(2), 118(1) 118(2) and 3(5) of BNS, vide FIR No.65 dated 03.05.2025, Police Station Shri Hargobindpur, Batala. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner for anticipatory bail.
2. Vide order dated 09.07.2025, the petitioner was afforded the benefit of interim anticipatory bail, with a direction to him to join investigation.
3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in compliance with above mentioned order, dated 09.07.2025, the petitioner has already joined investigation.
4. In view of abovementioned contention, on the instructions of ASI Sakattar Singh, Police Station Hargobindpura, Batala, who is present in the Court, the learned State Counsel has stated that in compliance with the order



dated 09.07.2025, the petitioner has joined investigation. He has further stated that the presence of petitioner is not required for the investigation of present case.

5. In view of the above mentioned submission of learned State counsel, the order dated 09.07.2025, whereby interim bail was granted to the petitioner, is hereby made absolute.

Present petition stands allowed, accordingly.
