Prayer in the instant application i.e., CM-11877-C-2023 preferred under Section 151 CPC is for disposal of the appeal in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties which was reduced to writing by way of compromise deed dated 25.09.2023 (Annexure A-1).

2. It has been averred in the application that the dispute has been amicably settled as a result of which parties do not wish to proceed further with the litigation. Learned counsel for the applicant-respondent submits that the appeal be disposed off in terms of the compromise.

3. Learned counsel for the non-applicant-appellant does not dispute the aforesaid factual situation. He submits that a compromise has indeed been arrived at between the parties which has been reduced into writing vide compromise deed dated 25.09.2023. He agrees to the prayer made by learned counsel for the applicant-respondent.

4. That being so, the present application i.e., CM-11877-C of 2023 is allowed and the appeal is disposed of in terms of compromise dated 25.09.2023 (Annexure A-1) arrived at between the parties. The said compromise be made a part of the decree.
