The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for setting aside the order 27.07.2022 (Annexure P-22) passed by learned Financial Commissioner, Punjab; order dated 22.10.2020 (Annexure P-18) passed by learned Sub Divisional Magistrate-cum-Collector, Kharar and order dated 11.09.2019 (Annexure P-13) passed by learned Naib Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Majri.

2. A perusal of order sheets would reveal that on last two occasions, the matter has been adjourned either on the request on behalf of the petitioner or due to absence of learned counsel for the petitioner.
