JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to grant Assured Career Progression (in short 'ACP') w.e.f. 12.11.2017 on completion of 8 years' service as Junior Engineer-1. He is further seeking promotion to the post of Assistant Engineer w.e.f. 27.10.2023 i.e. the date on which his junior has been promoted.

2. On being confronted with the fact that ACP, if any, was due in 2017 and instant petition is filed in 2025 i.e. after a period of 8 years from the date of cause of action, Mr. Sunil Kumar Nehra (Sirsa), Advocate does not press his prayer *qua* ACP. Mr. Nehra further submits that grievance of the petitioner would be redressed if respondents are directed to consider his claim for promotion in a time bound manner.



3. Ms. Jyotsna Saini, Advocate, who on advance notice is present in Court, filed her Memo of Appearance on behalf of all the respondents and submits that competent authority would consider petitioner's claim for promotion and pass an appropriate order within 3 months from today.

4. Mr. Nehra agrees to the aforesaid arrangement.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, instant petition stands disposed of.
