VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J. (Oral)

1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India against the orders dated 10.01.2025 and 13.03.2025 passed by learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kapurthala, whereby the suit against defendant No.3 was dismissed for want of filing of the application for impleading LRs and against defendant No.2 for non-filing of correct address.
2. Perusal of the record appended with the paper book shows that sufficient opportunities were granted for impleading the LRs of defendant No.3 as well as for filing of correct address of defendant No.2 and even the costs were imposed for doing the needful but neither the costs were deposited nor the orders of the Court were complied with and thereafter, the impugned orders were passed by the Court finding no other way but to dismiss the suit against defendant No.2 and 3 respectively.
3. There is no illegality or infirmity in the orders passed by the Courts below but in the interest of justice the impugned orders are set aside and one



opportunity is granted to the petitioner to comply with the order of the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Kapurthala, subject to the payment of cost of Rs.25,000/- to be deposited in the funds maintained by Punjab State Legal Services Authority for providing aid to flood victims.

4. The present petition stands disposed of, so also the pending miscellaneous application, if any.
