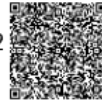

1. Sh. Parminderdeep Singh is defendant in Sh. Babanpreet Singh's suit for grant of decree of declaration with a consequential relief of mandatory injunction.
2. Sh. Parminderdeep Singh authorized his father Sh. Balwinder Singh through Special Power of Attorney dated 18.12.2019 to pursue, continue, defend, contest, prosecute the proceedings in the above cases/revision petitions against him and further if case is filed against him by anyone. Sh. Balwinder Singh filed an application to appear as a witness on behalf of his son Sh. Parminderdeep Singh, which has been allowed by the trial Court. The plaintiff assails the correctness of the aforesaid order on the ground that in the Special Power of Attorney, there is no reference with respect to Civil Suit No.21 of 2019, hence, Sh. Balwinder Singh cannot appear as a witness.
3. This Court has considered the submissions of learned counsel representing the parties.



4. It is evident that Special Power of Attorney was executed by Sh. Parminderdeep Singh in favour of his father Sh. Balwinder Singh. In this attorney, he was also authorized to defend any other case, which is filed against him by anyone.

5. Hence, there is no error in the order passed by the trial Court.

6. Dismissed accordingly.
