HARKESH MANUJA, J. (Oral)

1. Mr. Munish Sharma, Deputy Commissioner, Charkhi Dadri, who has joined the proceedings through video-conferencing submits that the representation submitted by the petitioners with respect to claim of rights under the provisions of Haryana Dholidar, Butimar, Bhonedar and Muqararidar (Vesting of Proprietary Rights) Act, 2010 shall be considered and decided within two weeks from today and a copy thereof shall be communicated to them within a week thereafter.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.
3. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.
4. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
