1. Prayer in the present petition is for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.1 vide order dated 31.07.2024 (Annexure P-1), passed in CRM-M-23744-2024 titled "Rajveer Singh vs. State of Punjab & Another", in case FIR No.119 dated 28.12.2023, registered under Sections 406 and 498-A of the IPC, registered at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that respondent No.1 was granted anticipatory bail by this Court subject to certain conditions, one of them being that the petitioner shall not leave the country without prior permission of this Court and shall surrender his passport, as is also contained under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. However, in violation of the same, the petitioner did not surrender his passport, and has even had left the country without obtaining any prior permission from this Court.

3. Learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Shispal Singh, submits that the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioner are indeed

correct. Respondent No.1 travelled to Doha, from where he further went to Italy, from where, he has applied for renewal of his passport.

3. It is settled proposition of law that once bail has been granted, it would require cogent and overwhelming circumstances for its cancellation. In the case at hand, respondent No.1 in blatant disregard and in gross violation of the conditions imposed on him by this Court while granting him the concession of anticipatory bail, has left the country without obtaining any prior permission. In view of the same, present petition is allowed, and the anticipatory bail granted to the petitioner 31.07.2024 (Annexure P-1), passed in CRM-M-23744-2024 stands cancelled. Needless to say, the investigating agency is empowered to take appropriate action against respondent No.1 in accordance with law.
