Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for not implementing the judgment dated 22.5.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-8104-2023 titled as "Mohit Sheoran vs. Haryana Staff Selection Commission".

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing a speaking order dated 16.4.2025 by the respondent; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid order dated 16.4.2025 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.



Learned counsel for the petitioner admits that the order dated 22.5.2024 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with and order dated 16.4.2025 has been passed by the respondent-Haryana Staff Selection Commission, Panchkula, rejecting the claim of the petitioner.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed off** accordingly.

The petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the aforesaid speaking order as per law.
