This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 9 and not to interfere and harass the petitioners and to direct the official respondents to ensure the security of life and liberty of the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are in a live-in-relationship. The copies of 'Aadhaar' cards (Annexures P-1 and P-2) of petitioners No.1 and 2 have been placed on record.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Harkanwar Jeet Singh, A.A.G. Punjab, who is present in Court accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

5. Without commenting upon the validity of the said relationship, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 15.06.2025 (Annexure P-3) and take requisite action, if so warranted, as per the facts and circumstances of the matter in accordance with law.
