The appellants have challenged the order dated 15.07.2025 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Ludhiana, in terms of which, their application for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.66 dated 05.07.2025, under Sections 115(2), 127(2), 351 of BNS, Section 67-B of I.T. Act and Section 3 of SC/ST, Act (Section 66-A of I.T., Act deleted), registered at Police Station Meharban, Ludhiana, has been dismissed

2 Learned State counsel, on instructions from ACP Sumit Sood, has apprised the Court that in compliance of the order dated 22.08.2025 passed by this Court, the appellants have joined the investigation and their further investigation is not required.
