1. Present petition has been filed praying for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.153, dated 15.12.2024, under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 351(2), 191(3), 190 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (for brevity, 'the BNS'), and Sections 117(1), 118(2) of BNS, added subsequently, registered at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender and file an appropriate application for bail before the trial Court. He further prays that direction be issued to learned trial Court to decide his bail application in a time bound manner.

3. Allowed as prayed for.
