The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 483 of BNSS seeking interim bail to the petitioner for 6 weeks (for the medical treatment of his wife namely Mrs. Geeta w/o Khemachand @ Pannu Vaid) in FIR No.608 dated 24.07.2024 registered under Sections 20 & 29 of NDPS Act at Police Station Sector 58, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the wife of the petitioner is suffering from piles and the doctor has advised immediate surgery for the same. He further submits that if the surgery is not done, there is a risk of excessive bleeding, anemia, infections and thrombosis. In support of his argument, he has placed on record the medical report dated 09.05.2025 (Annexure P-2).

Notice of motion.

Mr. Chetan Sharma, DAG Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent/State.

Considering the medical ailment of wife of the petitioner, who has been advised immediate surgery, this petition deserves to be allowed.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to be released on interim regular bail by tomorrow on furnishing a local surety to the satisfaction of the Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned. The petitioner shall also provide the address where he will reside during the period of interim bail at the time of submitting the surety bonds before the trial court.

The petitioner shall surrender to the Jail Authorities by 20.06.2025 before 5.00 PM.

The petition is disposed off, in the aforesaid terms.
