SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for disobedience and non-compliance of order dated 02.08.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-18257-2014.
2. The above said writ petition was disposed of in terms of the decision dated 18.05.2024 rendered in CWP No. 11705-2024. The relevant portion of order dated 18.05.2024 passed by this Court in CWP No. 11705-2024 is reproduced as under:-

“After going through the present writ petition and hearing the counsel from both the sides, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose of the present writ petition, with a direction to decide the representation dated 29.04.2024 (Annexure P-7) filed by the petitioners, within a period of three months from today, by passing a speaking order.

Needless to say that in case, petitioners are found to be entitled for the claim raised by way of present writ petition, same would be extended to them, without any unnecessary delay.”

3. Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the above order, speaking order dated 29.11.2024 has been passed by Registrar, Panjab University, Chandigarh. This fact is not disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.
4. In view of the above, order dated 02.08.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-18257-2014 has already been complied with, as speaking order dated 29.11.2024 has been passed.
5. Accordingly, the contempt is purged. Rule is *discharged*.
6. Pending application (s) if any also stands disposed of.
