Present petition filed under Section 528 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to official respondent Nos.1 to 3 to take necessary action on the legal notice/representation dated 05.12.2024 (P-2) and also for registration of FIR against respondent Nos.4 & 5.

2. This Court on 27.01.2025 had passed the following order:
