1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 05.07.2019 passed by the Additional Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Hoshiarpur whereby the Court has ordered to execute the warrant of possession by breaking open the lock of the premise in dispute.

2. It has been brought to the notice of this Court that vide order dated 20.07.2019, the decree holder has given a statement that the possession has been delivered to her and she does not wish to pursue the execution application and has withdrawn the same, thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of as such.
