AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

Power of attorney filed by counsel for respondents No.1, 2
and 3 separately, are taken on record.

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellants
as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum
of Rs.7,80,000/- (Rupees Seven Lacs and Eighty Thousand only), over
and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the
appellants in full and final settlement of the claim.

Learned counsel for the appellants stated that agreed amount
be released in favour of appellant No.1-Sunita. It was further undertaken
that in case in future any claim is raised by any other claimant-
appellant(s), the appellant No.1-Sunita shall indemnify the said
claimant(s).

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the
Insurance Company to deposit cheque of Rs.7,80,000/- (Rupees Seven

Lacs and Eighty Thousand only) in favour of appellant No.1-Sunita with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 25.07.2025. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.

Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
