Prayer in this petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for not complying the interim order dated 05.7.2023 (Annexure P-3) passed in CR-2557-2023 titled as "Ram Pal vs. Raju and others" vide which while notice of motion was issued, the parties were directed to maintain status quo as exists on the date of passing of the order dated 05.7.2023, with regard to the property in question.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in violation of the said order, the respondents were carrying on construction on the suit premises, as evident from the photographs (Annexures P-4).

Learned counsel for respondent No.1 hands over a copy of the order dated 1.5.2025 passed in the aforesaid Civil Revision



No.2557 of 2023, whereby the said civil revision has been dismissed as the possession of the respondents over the suit property was not proved. The copy of the said order is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner. It is submitted that accordingly the allegation of violation made by the petitioner is unfounded. It is also pointed out by learned counsel for respondent No.1 that the petitioner has also filed a petition under Order 39 Rule 2-A CPC for punishing respondent No.1 for violating the ad interim injunction granted in favour of the petitioner vide order dated 20.1.2022 passed by the Civil Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that the said is a separate cause of action.

Heard.

Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions of learned counsel for respondent No.1, the present contempt petition is **dismissed.**

Rule stands discharged.
