1. The present appeal has been preferred against the order dated 28.07.2004 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Court, Gurgaon, whereby, the appellant was sentenced to undergo as under:-

Sr. No.	Section	Imprisonment
1.	363/34 of IPC	To undergo RI for two years with fine of Rs.300/- and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo RI for three months.
2.	366-A/34 of IPC	To undergo RI for three years with fine of Rs.500/- and in default of payment of fine, to further undergo RI for six months.
All the sentences shall run concurrently.		

2. The present appeal was admitted vide order dated 12.08.2004



and the concession of suspension of sentence was granted to the appellant on dated 25.10.2004.

3. Vide order dated 19.05.2025, the appellant was put to notice as the counsel appearing for him had no instructions. As per the office report, the appellant-Kamal has expired on 31.10.2024 and the said report is already on record.

4. In light of the above, the present appeal is disposed of as abated.
