Petitioners, who have been arrayed as accused in case FIR No.151 dated 01.11.2019 registered against them at the instance of respondent No.2- Vinod Kumar (complainant) for commission of offences punishable u/s 420/465/467/468/471/120B IPC at Police Station Bahawala, District Fazilka, have filed the present petition for quashing of the aforesaid FIR along with all consequential proceedings emanating therefrom.
