The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of the FIR No.0064 dated 25.05.2021, under Sections 354-A, 500, 503, 506, 509 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar (Annexure A-1).

On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed:-

“Learned State counsel while referring to averments made in Para 9 of the short reply filed on behalf of respondent No.1-State of Punjab submits that the petitioner has availed an alternative remedy by filing an application for discharge before the learned trial Court, which is still pending consideration and therefore, the instant petition seeking quashing of the FIR is not maintainable.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is not present.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 14.05.2025.”

Learned State counsel submits that the said discharge application is still pending for 25.08.2025.



Even today also, learned counsel for the petitioner is not present.

Since the petitioner has been availing two parallel remedies at one point of time, therefore, the present petition is dismissed being not maintainable.
