1. The present writ petition has been moved under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent to implement decision dated 22.12.2011 (Annexure P-1) taken by Board of Directors as well as the judgment passed by this Court in ***Manohar Lal Sharma and others vs. Haryana State Industrial and Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd. and another*** in ***CWP-6090-2013*** decided on 29.01.2015(Annexure P-2) whereby similarly situated persons have received the benefits of the said decision(Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied if the representation dated 19.12.2024 (Annexure P-5) moved by the petitioners is decided by the respondent by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.



3. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that he has no objection in case a direction is issued to the respondent for time-bound consideration and decision of the representation dated 19.12.2024 (Annexure P-5) by passing a speaking order.

4. Therefore, in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the respondent is directed to consider the representation dated 19.12.2024 (Annexure P-5) and pass a speaking order after affording the petitioners an opportunity to be heard, within a period of 03 months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. Further, the decision taken thereof shall be conveyed to the petitioners. Needless to say, if the petitioners are found entitled to the relief sought, the same shall be granted forthwith by the respondent.

5. Disposed of, accordingly.
