1. Through the instant petition, as cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a mandamus upon the competent respondent amongst the respondents, to issue death certificate, qua the husband of the petitioner, namely, Balkar Singh.
2. This Court, vide order dated 14.01.2025, had directed the learned State counsel, to produce the death certificate pertaining to the husband of the petitioner.
3. In deference to the directions (supra), short reply dated 17.02.2025, by way of affidavit of Mr. Kulwinder Singh, Superintendent, Central Jail, Shri Goindwal Sahib, along with copy of death certificate (Annexure R-1), on behalf of the respondents, furnished by the learned State counsel, today in the Court. The same is taken on record.
4. In view of the fact that the death certificate has been issued to the petitioner, therefore, no further direction is required to be passed in the instant writ petition, and the same is hereby **closed**.
5. **Disposed of** accordingly.
