1. Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to order dated 14.02.2023 (Annexure P-9), in CRM-M-48089-2022, titled as **Vijay Kumar Saini V/s Central Bureau of Investigation and Others**, wherein FIR No.RC5A of 2002 dated 26.09.2002, Police Station CBI ACUIV New Delhi, under Sections 420 & 120-B IPC, whereby it was quashed qua the petitioners therein, based on the statements made.
