1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.82 dated 26.04.2024, registered under Section 409 IPC at Police Station City South, District Moga.
2. By virtue of order dated 27.05.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that both the sides have amicably resolved their issue and no dispute remained among them. He submits that even otherwise, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
4. Learned counsel for the complainant has affirmed the fact that the parties have compromised the matter.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nachhattar Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
