Through the instant second petition, filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS), a prayer is made for grant of relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.0078, dated 22.08.2024 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 420, 468, 471 and 120-B of IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Joga, District Mansa, Punjab.
2. The first anticipatory bail application, having been dismissed as withdrawn, vide order dated 03.10.2024 (Annexure-P-3), the instant petition has been filed, without there being any supervening event or change in the circumstance. Therefore, this Court is not inclined to consider the case of the present petitioner, to grant the asked for relief (supra).
3. Accordingly, the instant petition is, hereby, **dismissed**.
