Through the instant petition filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (For short "BNSS"), the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.437, dated 13.06.2023 under Sections 147, 149, 323, 307, 365, 379-B, 427, 506 and 120-B of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act (Sections 147 and 325 IPC added and Section 148 IPC deleted later on), registered at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad.
2. Status report filed by learned State counsel is taken on record.
3. Vide order dated 21.05.2025, passed by this Court, the petitioner was released on interim bail and was directed to join investigation.
4. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioner has joined investigation on 26.05.2025 and he is not required for custodial interrogation.
5. Keeping in view the above facts and circumstances, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 21.05.2025, granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
