**ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (Oral)**

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are *Jhuggi* dwellers and their *Jhuggis* are being demolished. He submits that in the event of the respondents demolishing their *Jhuggis*, they ought to be rehabilitated.

2. Issue notice to the respondents.

3. At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1.

4. Mr. Deepak Bhardwaj, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.2 and 3 and upon instructions submits that construction raised by the petitioners was illegal and has been demolished in accordance with law.

5. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be preferring an application for their rehabilitation to respondent No.2, which may be directed to be decided in a time bound manner.

6. In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to move an application for rehabilitation to respondent No.2, who is directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with their policy within one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
