1. A request for a hearing through Video Conferencing by learned counsel for the petitioner.
2. The present contempt petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 18.06.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed in CRM-M-No. 30152-2024 by which it was directed as follows:-

*“In view of the above, petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 - Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali, to look into the representation and to take appropriate action, if any required, as per law, within a period of three weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order and also convey the same to the petitioner.”*

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in compliance of the said directions a speaking order dated 19.07.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.

4. Heard.

5. In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same stands **disposed of**.

6. However, in case, any cause of action survives, the petitioner is at liberty to revive the present petition within a period of two weeks from today.

7. Rule stands discharged.
