1. Prayer in the present petition filed under 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking directions to official respondent Nos.2 and 3 to transfer investigation of FIR bearing No.21 dated 11.02.2025 registered under Sections 126(2), 310(3) of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Nagina, District Nuh (Mewat) to any other independent police district outside district Nuh (Mewat).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the private respondents used to harass the daughter of petitioner, on account of demand of dowry. Many times, the petitioner used to bring his daughter at his home but on being apologized and to save the matrimonial life, he used to send her back to her in-laws house. He further submits that on 10.02.2025 at about 5 O' Clock, daughter of the petitioner and her husband came to meet him and at about 8:30 PM, they went back. Thereafter, the nephew of the petitioner received a telephonic call about the death of his daughter. As such, husband and in-laws of the daughter of the petitioner have killed her on account of



demand of dowry, by hatching a criminal conspiracy. He further submits that the petitioner has submitted representations dated 11.02.2025, 17.03.2025 and 02.04.2025 (Annexures P-3 to P-5 respectively) to respondent Nos.3, 4 and I.G., Rewari Range, Rewari, but no action was taken.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner, in a time bound manner.

4. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

5. Ms. Geeta Sharma, DAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to supply a copy of complete paper book to learned State counsel today itself.

6. Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioners and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps in view of the submissions made therein, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
