

## RINKU V/S DILBAG SINGH BISLA AND OTHERS

Perusal of case file reveals that vide order dated 27.03.2023, a co-ordinate Bench of this Court had referred the case to the Daily Lok Adalat, to explore the possibility of an amicable settlement between the parties; and also ordered to list the main appeal on 14.08.2023, to await the outcome thereof.

Pursuant thereto, the main appeal was disposed of by the Daily Lok Adalat, Bench No. 4 vide order dated 11.05.2023 as, the matter stands settled for a sum of ₹4,10,000/- as full and final settlement of the claim of the appellant over and above the amount already awarded by the learned Tribunal. However, inadvertently, the present appeal could not be listed on 14.08.2023 before this Court. Hence, the office has put up the file by way of IOIN.

Learned counsel appearing for the appellant very fairly admits that the matter already stands decided in Lok Adalat and nothing survives in the present appeal.

Accordingly, no further order is required to be passed in the present case.

IOIN stands disposed of.
