Memo of Appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2 has been filed today by Mr.Tarun Yadav, Advocate.

On 27.02.2025, on behalf of the appellants statement was made to accept ₹10,75,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of the Insurance Company concurrence has been given to this effect. Thus, a sum of ₹10,75,000/- (₹ Ten Lakh Seventy Five Thousand Only) is allowed to the appellants against the Insurance Company. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.2 - Smt. Renu w/o Shri Vijay Sehgal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹10,75,000/- in the name of appellant No.2 - Smt. Renu w/o Shri Vijay Sehgal with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within six weeks, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The
