Present petition has been filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No. 578 dated 30.11.2024, under Sections 3,5,13 of Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 (for short 'Act, 2015') [Section 17 of Act, 2015 and Section 238 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 added later on], registered at Police Station Sadar Dabwali, District Sirsa.
