1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing respondent No.2 to decide the statutory appeal dated 24.03.2025 preferred by the petitioner against the punishment order dated 24.02.2025 passed by respondent No.1.
2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner relied upon order passed by this Court in **CWP No.5936 of 2025** titled '**Dipali Goyal and another Vs. The Appellate Authority the Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd and another** decided on **04.03.2025**.
3. Notice of motion.
4. Mr. Anil Sharma, Advocate assisted by Ms. Devyani Sharma, Advocate for respondents No. 1 and 2 enter appearance and accept notice on behalf of respondents. Learned counsel submits that the appeal filed by the petitioner shall be decided expeditiously.
