1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 of Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.231 dated 09.11.2024, under Sections 319(2), 318(4), 60 & 62 of BNS, registered at Police Station Sector-31, Chandigarh (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to surrender before the concerned Court and then to move an application for seeking regular bail.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed.
4. However, it is clarified that in case, the petitioner surrenders before the concerned Court within a period of one week from today, the bail application filed by him would be decided within next three days by the Court.
