1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 for registration of FIR at Police Station Balongi, District SAS Nagar Mohali, pursuant to the registration of Zero FIR No.10 dated 22.05.2025 under Sections 115, 69 of the BNS, 2023 registered at Police Station Women Police Station, Panchkula, District Panchkula.

2. On receipt of advance copy of the paperbook, learned State counsel has produced a copy of the letter dated 22.08.2025 issued by Senior Superintendent of Police, S.A.S. Nagar, to the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, which reads as under: -
