1. Prayer made in the present petition is for directing the respondents to conclude the recruitment process initiated pursuant to the advertisement dated 24.06.2019 in a time bound manner.

2. Learned State counsel refers to paras 4 to 6 of the additional affidavit of the Under Secretary to Govt. of Punjab, Department of Health and Family Welfare, dated 24.08.2023, as well as Annexures R1/T and R2/T, to state that a decision had been taken to scrap the recruitment process and as a matter of fact, inquiry was also initiated for taking action against the responsible officers/employees, who started the recruitment



process for the post of Audiometry Technician without taking approval from the competent authority, a fact that learned counsel for the petitioners was unable to controvert.
