1. Petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to arrange appropriate security for the church premises especially on Sunday's prayers.
2. Status report dated 16.03.2025 by way of an affidavit of Pravesh Gupta Chopra, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, South, Amritsar has already been filed on behalf of respondent-State.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of para No.6 of the status report, security is being provided by SHO of the concerned Police and SSP Amritsar Rural and he is satisfied with the action taken by the Police on his petition and the petition may be disposed of as infructuous.



4. Ordered accordingly.

5. However, in case petitioner feels any threat perception with regard to the church premises, adequate security shall be provided.
