1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.0127 dated 05.07.2024, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC read with Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professionals (Regulation) Act, 2014, at Police Station Sadar Sri Muktsar Sahib, District Sri Muktsar Sahib (Annexure P-1).
2. Vide order dated 14.07.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 14.07.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.



4. Learned State counsel, on instructions has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.
5. Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
6. In view of the above, interim order dated 14.07.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) B.N.S.S.
7. Petition stands allowed.
