Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents No.1 and 2 to initiate enquiry on the complaints dated 22.10.2024 (Annexures P-15 and P-16), reminders dated 25.11.2024 (Annexure P-18) and 13.12.2024 (Annexure P-19).

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to avail his other remedies as available to him, in accordance with law.
