1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against respondents for non-compliance of order dated 26.05.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by this court in CWP No.21766 of 2018.

2. In compliance of order dated 26.05.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by this court in CWP No.21766 of 2018, the counsel for the State has placed on record order dated 13.02.2024 passed by the respondent, which is taken on record.

3. The counsel for the respondent-State, after going through the aforesaid affidavit, has submitted that the petitioner has been reinstated in the service. Hence, no further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.
