Vide order dated 09.11.2022, learned counsel for the appellant had sought time to implead legal representatives of the deceased appellant. Thereafter, time was once again sought and granted for the same purpose vide order dated 16.03.2023. However, needful has not been done till date.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the appellant submits that they have tried to contact the legal representatives of the deceased appellant but there is no response from them. It is submitted that it seems that the legal representatives of the deceased appellant are not interested in pursuing the present appeal.

The aforesaid circumstances coupled with the fact that legal representatives of the deceased appellant have not been brought on record despite various opportunities granted and also waiting for a long period since 2022, it is clear that they are not interested in pursuing the present appeal.

In view of the above, the present appeal is hereby dismissed for non-prosecution.
