HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the benefits stand paid to all the petitioners except petitioners No.10 & 11, regarding whom also, the vouchers have been prepared and necessary release shall be made within 07 days from today.
2. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioners does not press the present petition.

4. However, in case the needful is not done, as per undertaking, the petitioners would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket

in favour of the petitioners towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application, if any.
