1. This order shall dispose off three bail petitions, i.e., CRM-M-43555-2024 titled as “**Shamsher Singh @ Shera Vs. State of Punjab**”, CRM-M-45561-2024 titled as “**Gurnoor Singh Vs. State of Punjab**” and CRM-M-1577-2025 titled as “**Daljit Singh @ Lally Vs. State of Punjab**”, whereby, the petitioner(s) have applied for grant of regular bail under Section 483 of the BNSS in case FIR No.31 dated 22.02.2024 under Sections 21(c), 27(a), 25/29/61/85 NDPS Act 1985, registered at Police Station Ajnala, Amritsar.

2. The FIR in the present case was initially registered against three persons, namely Hartej Singh, Mandeep Singh @ Gora and Lakhbir Singh. Pursuant to their arrest, 06 kgs of heroin and Rs.1,70,000/- as drug money were recovered from them. During the course of investigation, Lakhbir Singh, co-accused stated to have made a disclosure statement, naming Daljit Singh @ Lalli as an accused in the present case. Daljit Singh @ Lalli was arrested and he named 03 persons namely Gurnoor Singh, Sukhraj Singh and Bikramjit Singh as the suppliers. Bikramjit Singh was arrested on 29.02.2024 and he named Shamsher Singh @ Shera as one of the person, who had allegedly supplied the contraband to him. Learned counsel further submit that Gurnoor Singh (petitioner in CRM-M-45561-2024) was arrested on 06.03.2024, whereas Shamsher Singh @ Shera (petitioner in CRM-M-43555-2024) was arrested on



11.02.2024 and Daljit Singh @ Lally (petitioner in CRM-M-1577-2025) was arrested on 29.02.2024. Moreover, similarly placed co-accused Sukhraj Singh @ Raja has been allowed the concession of bail in CRM-M-34672-2025 on 10.07.2025 passed by this Court. Learned counsel further submit that in the present case, the prosecution has relied upon 28 witnesses and no witness has been examined so far. Moreover, the prosecution had moved an application for further investigation, which has been allowed by the trial Court. Thus, the custody of the petitioner(s) will not serve any useful purpose.

3. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner(s) on the ground that serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner(s) and they do not deserve the concession of bail by this Court. He has also filed status report in CRM-M-43555-2024 by way of an affidavit of the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural) on behalf of the respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

5. In the present case, the petitioner(s) are stated to be in custody for the last about 01 year and 05 months. It is admitted fact that even charge has not been framed against the petitioner(s) so far.



Moreover, a similarly placed co-accused Sukhraj Singh @ Raja has been allowed the concession of bail in CRM-M-34672-2025 on 10.07.2025 passed by this Court. Thus, the further custody of the petitioner(s) will not serve any useful purpose.

6. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petitions are allowed. The petitioner(s) are ordered to be released on bail pending trial on their furnishing bail bonds and surety to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/ Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate.
