Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent for not complying the order dated 30.8.2024 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-21291-2024 titled as "Surender and others vs. State of Haryana and others", vide which the petition was disposed of with a direction to "*....respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to decide the legal notices dated 17.06.2024, Annexures P-12 to P-16, expeditiously, taking note of the afore-referred judgments, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain*



*reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.”*

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that since the order dated 30.8.2024 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with and Speaking Order dated 15.11.2024 has been passed by the respondent-authority, the present petition may be disposed of as such.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State also submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing a speaking order dated 15.11.2024 by the respondent-authority; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid order dated 15.11.2024 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners. Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present petition is **disposed of** accordingly.

Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stands disposed of.
